### General Information

IT equipment is supplied to enable you to communicate remotely onsite and record work progress throughout the day.

This role is working March to November each year, with paid time off from December to February.

Apply herbicide from a quad and using a knapsack sprayer to control weeds and unwanted vegetation along highways, roadside verges, roundabouts, pathways, industrial sites, residential street, properties, and some open areas of land.

Following established Standard Operating Procedures , customer specific RAMS and carrying out audits and equipment calibrations as required.

Recording work carried out, and logging map distances covered, using web-based apps on a mobile phone.

Based from your home address, you will be travelling and working in different counties throughout the UK, staying away Mon-Fri on a regular basis. Working on amenity contacts won in multiple locations.
